Harvest Assembly, Christmas nativity</li> <li>• regular <b>class discussions</b> and drama through English and other areas of the curriculum, eg. discussion, debate, reflection</li> <li>• whole class and guided reading <b>discussions</b></li> <li>• school <b>productions</b>, eg.
