OFSTED visit – Infants

As many of you are aware, the Infants School received an OFSTED visit earlier this week. There were 2 inspectors who visited all Year 1 and 2 classes as well as Reception classes at Meadway over 2 days. There have been significant changes to the OFSTED framework since the school was last inspected in 2011 and the current inspection framework was described by the Chief Inspector as 'much more demanding'. That said, we did our very best to show the great things that Trafalgar does under the revised OFSTED categories: Quality of Education, Behaviour and Attitudes, Personal Development, Early Years and Leadership and Management

I would like to take the opportunity to thank you all for your amazing support. We had an overwhelming number of positive responses from the parent survey as well as lovely feedback from those who spoke to the inspectors at the gate at Elmsleigh Rd and Meadway. We also received some lovely cards and wishes as well as treats - 'Heros' for our staff who have worked so hard. The children did an amazing job with their learning, and many got to speak directly with the inspectors to talk about their roles and responsibilities in school.

The process will now take up to a month and we expect to receive the final report and grade early in the new year. In the meantime, we will remain optimistic for a positive outcome.

Punctuality

It is very important that your child arrives on time for school. Registration for KS1 and KS2 is at 8.55 am, and for EYFS registration is at 9.05 am. Children who are late miss their phonics session which follows registration, and also affects their friends in the class whose lesson gets disrupted. Thank you.

- Ask anyone in **The Alligator's Mouth.** This is an independent bookstore in Richmond that we work with regularly. As children's books specialists, their knowledge and stock is second to none!

If you have a child who was born between 1.9.19 and 31.8.20 you need to apply for a place in Reception 2024, even if you already have a child attending the school. Go to <u>www.richmond.gov.uk</u> and click on School Admissions to make your application. Closing date for applications is 15 January 2024.

Children who are in Y2 need to also apply for a place in the Junior School in September 2024. Go to <u>www.richmond.gov.uk</u> and click on School Admissions to make your application. Closing date for applications is 15 January 2024.
