EYFS

In Reception this week we have learnt the digraphs 'er' and 'air', with the phrases 'the bigger digger' and 'the chair in the air' to accompany them. The children have also been introduced to double letters in the middle of words; 2 letters that make 1 sound. For example, carrot, hammer, digger and kitten. The children are gaining confidence with their writing. Please encourage any sort of mark making at home, such as, writing a list for shopping or writing the names of their favourite toys on labels.

In Maths, we have been recognising the numbers 6,7 and 8 and counting out quantities of these amounts. Then, we thought about 1 more and 1 less than these totals. Singing counting rhymes, such as 'One man went to mow' and 'There were 8 in a bed', is a fun way to reinforce the concepts of more and less.

A big thank you to the parents who made our junk modelling challenge afternoon possible, whether it was by bringing in your recycling, or coming in to help on the day. The children had a brilliant time and in teams, made some amazing creations. Look out for photos in our Golden newsletter!

Parking

We have had a number of complaints from our neighbours at the Gothic Road/Elmsleigh Road site, and also at Meadway about parents who are consistently parking illegally on double yellow lines and blocking neighbours' drives. This is happening before school, after school and at after school clubs. We know there is limited parking around the schools, but there are areas within a short walking distance of the schools where you can park, legally and considerately and we ask you to use these spaces instead. Thank you.

Bikes and Scooters

Please note that there are places to store scooters in the Infants and the Juniors. As the Infants' area is rather small, you are welcome to park bikes or scooters in the Junior covered area by the Third Cross Rd gate.

Please remember to dismount when in the school grounds as it can become quite congested. We also ask that children take their bike or scooter home each night as these should not be left at school.

Please do not allow your children to go on the climbing frames either before or after school. The climbing frames are only used at playtimes and lunchtimes. Thank you.
