# Diversity Week: 24 - 28 June

LGBT+ pupils are twice as likely to be bullied, face daily tension at home and endure disproportionate challenges to their mental health – school must be the place where they can be themselves. More than 6,800 primary and secondary schools across the UK are now taking part.

It aims to foster an environment where every student feels valued and respected regardless of their background or identity. We believe that promoting inclusivity and understanding is crucial in developing well-rounded, empathetic individuals. #### **EYFS**

#### **TTRS Competition: London Rocks**

We are taking part in a fun and friendly Maths competition involving schools in London. The competition runs from 07:30 Tuesday 25th June 2024 to 19:30 Thursday 27th June 2024. It's all done online via <a href="https://ttrockstars.com/">https://ttrockstars.com/</a>

Children can play in any game mode with every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, earning themselves, their class and the school a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours, subject to a daily 60-minute limit (see below)). Winning classes in the school and in the competition as a whole will be the ones with the highest average.

To support player wellbeing, there is a daily time limit of 60-minutes per player. Once the player goes beyond 60-minutes of play on that day, they will still earn coins but will no longer earn points towards the competition. In the spirit of the competition, please don't play on their behalf but by all means encourage and support them.
